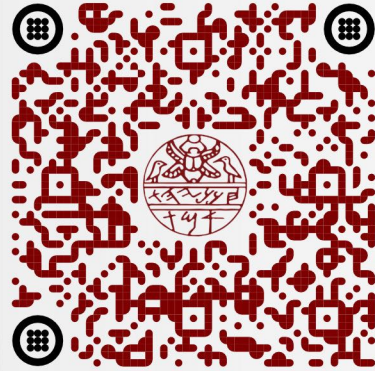

Benjamin Storchan is a research excavation archaeologist for the Jerusalem Region of the Israel Antiquities Authority. He is currently a PhD candidate at Ben Gurion University of the Negev, writing a dissertation on the metamorphosis of Byzantine churches in the Holy Land during the early Islamic Period. Storchan has directed several large-scale excavations, including the Glorious Martyr Excavation Project, Pre- and Proto-historic settlements at Eshta'ol, and landscape archaeology projects near Bet Shemesh. Storchan has researched oil lamp production in the late Roman and Byzantine-early Islamic periods.



Rev. Prof. Josef Mario Briffa SJ is a Roman Catholic priest and archaeologist. He is associate Professor at the Biblical Faculty of the Pontifical Biblical Institute in Rome (part of the Pontifical Gregorian University), teaching archaeology, geography, and ancient history of the Biblical world. He is also Director of Academic Programmes, and Curator of Museum and archaeological collection at the Pontifical Biblical Institute in Jerusalem. He is active in the field in Israel and is part of the team of the Lautenschläger Azekah Expedition since 2013.
